

“PORT CHECK” - Clean Air Fees
Effective November 17, 2008
\$35/20', \$70/40'

Per the Port of Long Beach Asst. Director of Communications/Public Information Officer (562-590-4123), most of the money is going to grants for the trucking industry to become compliant with the regulatory 2007 EPA emission standards.

The port estimates that by 2012, all trucks should be in compliance and hence this fee will no longer be collected.

Until then, whether it is the trucker, importer or broker, this fee will have to be “claimed” through Port Check (can be accessed on Pier Pass website) in order for the containers to be allowed to move in and out of the Port’s terminals. The only trucks allowed to access terminals will be trucks working for Licensed Motor Carriers with port-approved concessions that are registered in the port’s online Drayage Truck Registry, have paid their \$100 per truck registration fee and that have RFID tags.
